
1. Before you begin, enter into prayer with Marie-Louise, let the call of Christ Wisdom penetrate your inner self and prepare to welcome it and unite with Him.

This year, the Daughters of Wisdom are commemorating the 300th anniversary of the arrival of Blessed Marie-Louise de Jésus in Saint-Laurent-sur-Sèvre.
