



The Family That Prays Together...



**Stays Together** 

October is the "Month of the Rosary" and the feast day of "Our Lady of the Rosary" falls on 7 October. Pope St. Pius V established the two essential elements of the rosary: vocal prayer and mental prayer. This fact has been highlighted by all Marian saints, especially St. Louis Marie de Montfort (1673 – 1716), author of popular Marian books such as, "The Admirable Secret of the Rosary", "True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin" and "Methods for Saying the Rosary."

In the span of only five years Pope Leo XIII, an enthusiastic promoter of the rosary wrote eleven encyclicals on the rosary. St. John Paul II called the rosary his favourite prayer, "in which we meditate with Mary upon the mysteries which she as a Mother meditated in her heart" (Luke 2:19).

Our Blessed Mother has been known to appear many times and quite often she has reiterated a similar message: pray the rosary, at Lourdes 1858 and Fatima 1917. Fr Patrick Peyton, (January 9, 1909 - June 3, 1992), also known as "The Rosary Priest", was an Irish-born Catholic priest, member of the Congregation of Holy Cross, and founder of the Family Rosary Crusade. He popularised the phrases "The family that prays together stays together" and "A world at prayer is a world at peace." His cause for canonisation was opened in 2001 and Pope Francis declared him Venerable on December 18, 2017.

Today, many Catholic homes have lost true devotion of praying the family rosary together. Have we strayed from the path leading to heaven? Then call on Mary, for her name means "Star of the Sea," the North Star which guides the ships of our souls during the voyage of this life, and she will guide us to the harbour of eternal salvation

(St. Louis Marie de Montfort, The Secret of the Rosary).
