Blessing of the Enclosed Garden

It was a wonderful day of rejoicing at Montfort Centre with the Blessing of The Enclosed Garden on 31 January 2024. The blessing brought to a close the milestone celebration of 350 years since the birth of St. Louis Marie de Montfort (31 January 1673).

The Reverend Msgr Peter Zhang who presided at the blessing reflected on the juxtaposition of the two statues in the garden: one symbolic of Eve, crouched and cowering in shame and another of Mary, joyfully open to life aglow with praise.

The Enclosed Garden is used by St. Louis Marie de Montfort in his writing 'The Secret of Mary' to describe Mary as God's own Paradise. It is in this very garden where the Holy Spirit reveals the secret of Mary; that she is the Tree of Life and whoever goes to her will only find Jesus, the Blessed Fruit of her womb.

The blessing was well attended by benefactors and friends of Montfort Centre and God truly affirmed His presence by sending waves of gentle breezes throughout the prayer.
